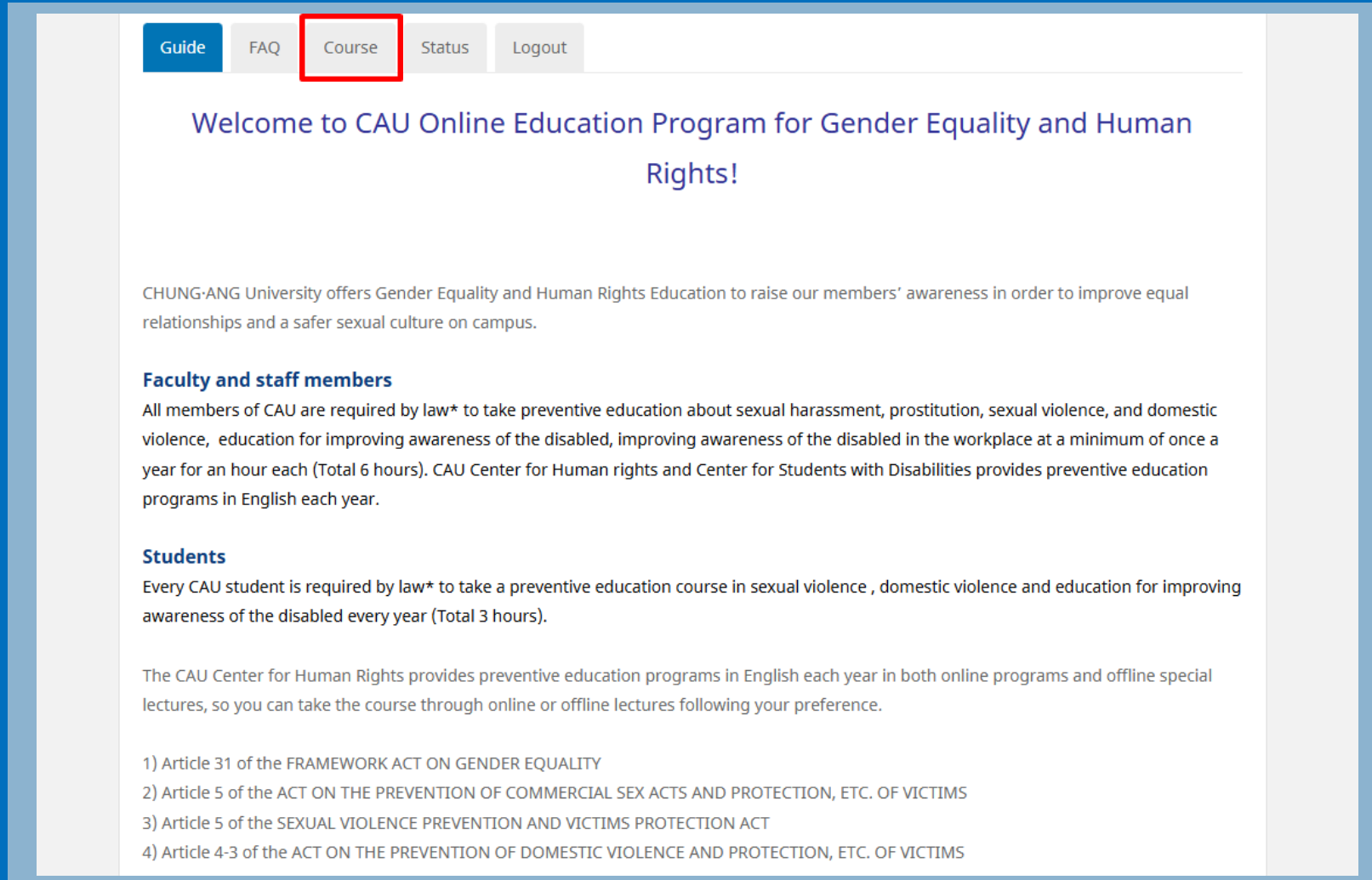

□ 법적 근거

- [양성평등기본법] 제31조
- [성매매방지 및 피해자보호 등에 관한 법률] 제5조
- [성폭력방지 및 피해자보호 등에 관한 법률] 제5조
- [가정폭력방지 및 피해자보호 등에 관한 법률] 제4조의3

* 이 법률들에 따라 교직원(교수/강사)은 성희롱·성매매·성폭력·가정폭력 등 4개 예방교육, 학생(학부생/대학원생)은 성폭력·가정폭력 등 2개 예방교육을 각 과목별로 매년 1시간 이상씩 이수하여야 합니다.

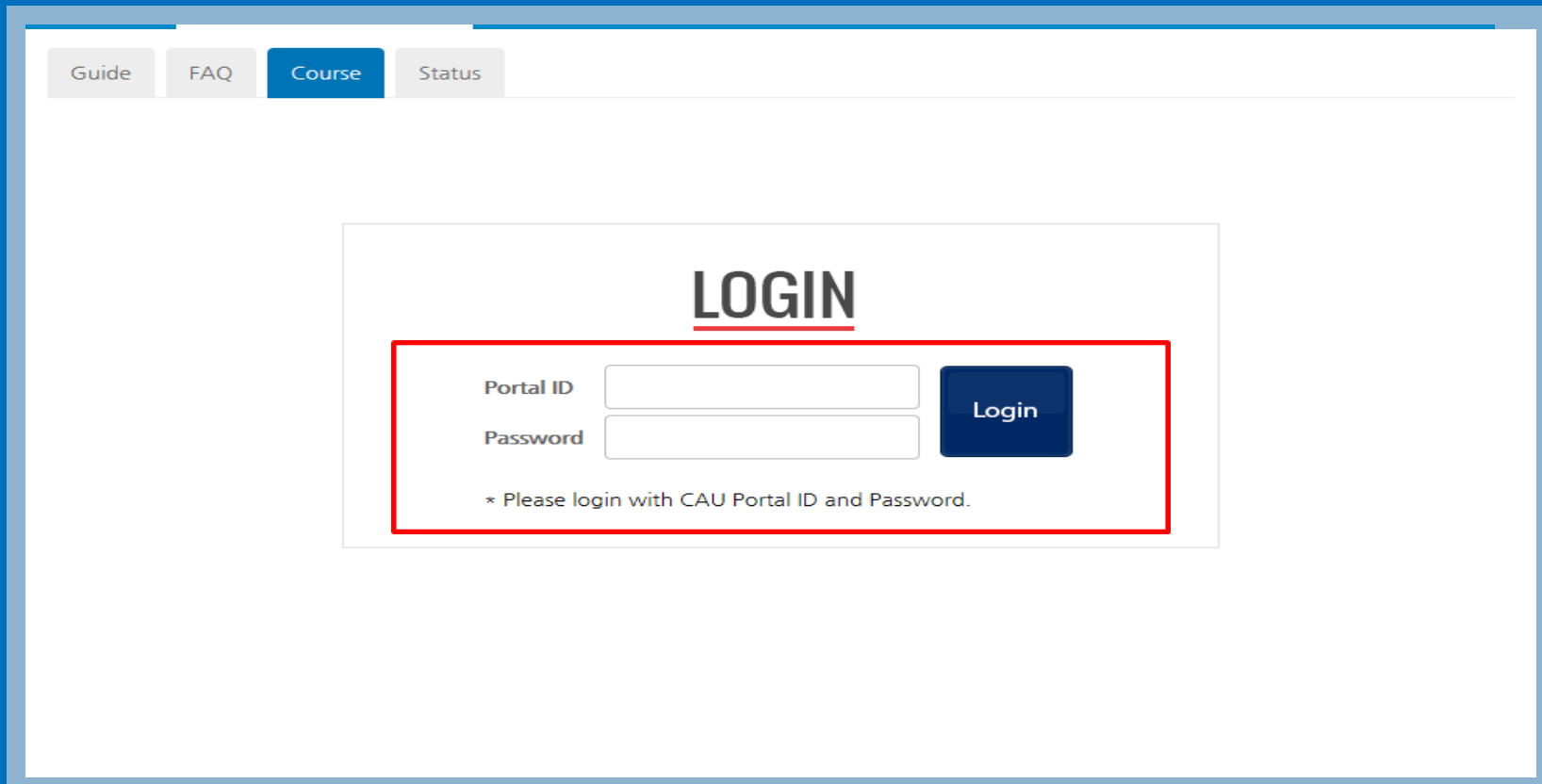
Students

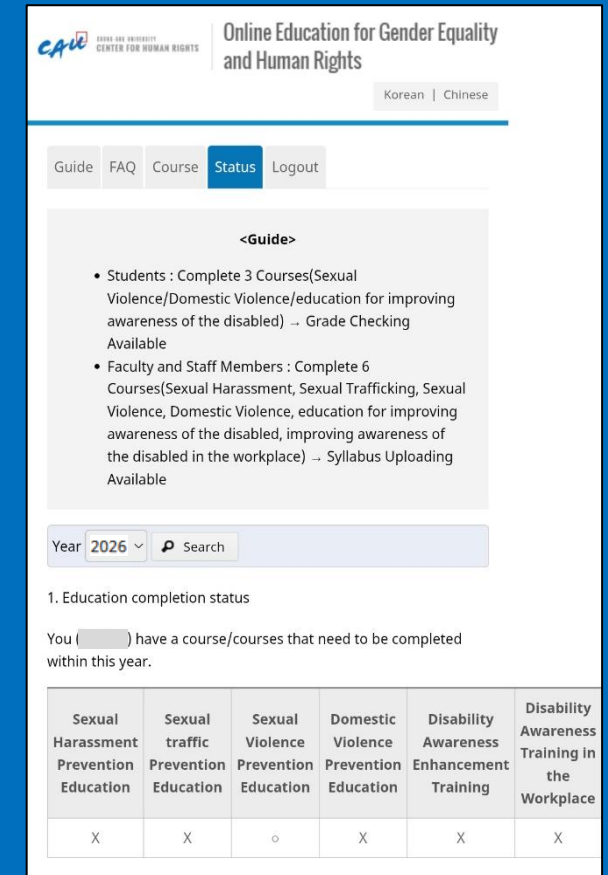
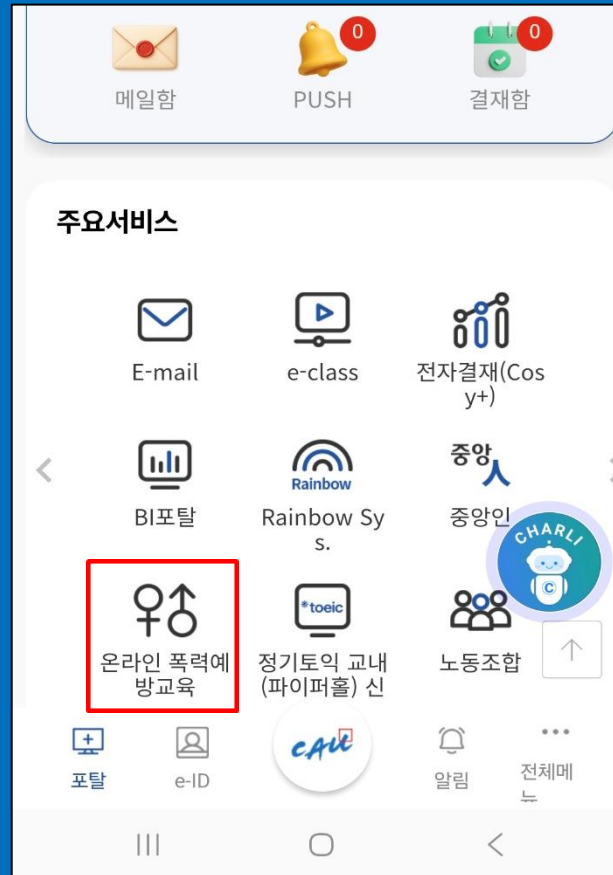
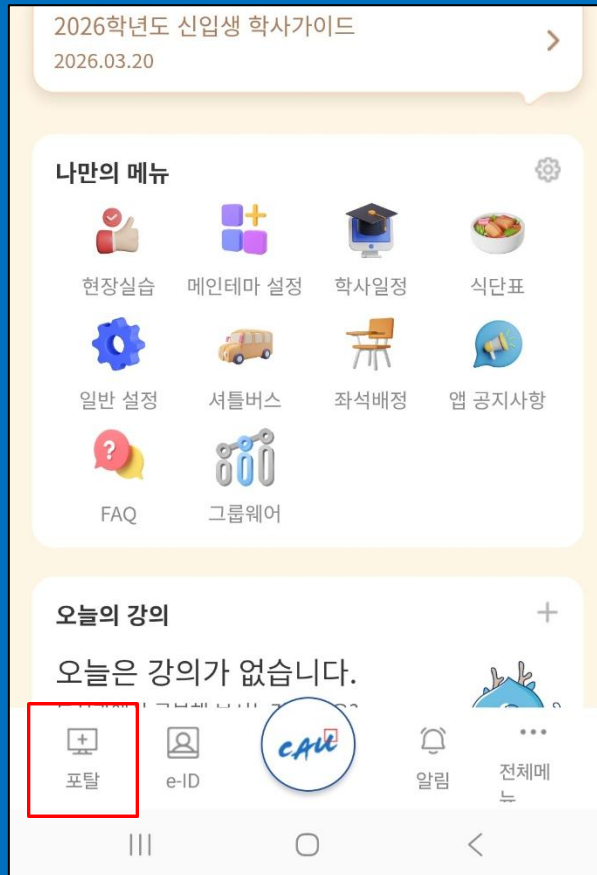
